## Recent Legislative Initiatives in the U.S.

- The Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 and last reauthorized in 2008
- Since 2003, 46 U.S. States and the District of Columbia have signed legislation into law
- In 2011, 155 bill were introduced in 33 states to combat some aspect of human trafficking

## **New Questions**

- How is the four paradigm approach—
  <u>prosecution</u>, <u>protection</u>, <u>prevention</u>, and
  <u>partnerships</u>—to combating human trafficking
  working in practice?
- How are recent initiatives working in practice?
- Which specific policies and programs are working well in practice?
- Which specific policies and programs are not working well?
